Update of the System Firmware installed at the factory to support the 5th Gen Intel® Xeon® processors:

- BMC: 1.95
- CPLD: 3.0
- FRU: 0.07

*"WARNING: This Server is running factory firmware. A software update is required. As part of your system integration process, please load the latest system update package (SUP) to enable the latest security, quality and performance."*

### Customer Impact of Change and Recommended Action:

The primary value of this factory BIOS is that it allows the customer to perform a single BIOS programming (upgrade or downgrade) without the requirement of moving the BIOS Recovery physical jumper. Once the first programming is done, any subsequent attempts to downgrade from a revision that includes a security update will require moving the BIOS Recovery physical jumper.

MiTAC does not expect any impact to customers from these changes but encourages customers to understand the change and determine the impact on their applications.
